

Lions International, State & District Addresses for Dues & Contributions

Your Lions Club's individual dues/contributions are important to the Lions Association and the programs/projects it supports. To make sure that your dues/contributions get credited properly it is important to address the check correctly to the respective organization/programs/projects. Only one organization should be listed on the check, with the specific program or fund of interest listed on the check's memo line (for example, for a Melvin Jones contribution, the check should be addressed to "LCIF" and the memo line should read "Melvin Jones Fellowship").

I. ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS (CREDIT CARD OR E-CHECK):

Club Treasurers with a valid MyLCI User ID and password may pay by credit card via MyLCI on the Lions Clubs International website. After logging onto MyLCI, choose **CLUB, STATEMENT** and **PAY NOW**. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express credit and debit cards are accepted.
